Interested teams are welcome to apply with the following criteria:

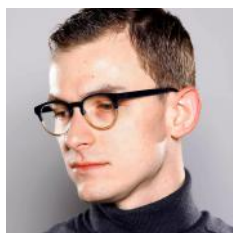
- Film was completed in 2019 / 2020, or is in development with a complete script
- Film's total runtime is 30 minutes or less
- Applicant must be a Singapore Citizen / Permanent Resident

Eligible and complete submissions will be evaluated on the strength of the project's track record. Selection will be competitive and limited to 12 projects. Documents to be submitted can be found at the registration link below.

His recent works as producer include *Malila: The Farewell Flower* (2017), which was Thailand's Best Foreign Language Film submission to the 91st Academy Awards.



Pawel Wieszczeinski (USA) is the founder of Kinoscope – a curated streaming service devoted to short and feature films by emerging cinematic talent.
