Reopening of Cinemas from 13 July 2020

1. The Multi-Ministry Taskforce (MTF) announced on 15 June 2020 that more businesses will be allowed to resume activities in Phase 2, starting from 19 June.

Reopening of Cinemas

2. Cinemas will be allowed to reopen from 13 July 2020 and must adhere to the following set of **Mandatory Safe Management Measures for Cinemas** found here (hyperlink to pdf).
3. The Infocomm Media Development Authority (IMDA) and Singapore Film Commission (SFC) have assessed that the **Mandatory Safe Management Measures for Cinemas** meets the necessary precautionary measures for managing the COVID-19 related risks in cinemas.
4. The **Mandatory Safe Management Measures for Cinemas** are a result of consultation with key industry stakeholders.

MANDATORY SAFE MANAGEMENT MEASURES FOR CINEMAS

Following the Government's latest directive, it is mandatory for everyone to wear a mask at all times in the cinema.

Our Staff

All staff to monitor their health, wear masks and wash their hands frequently



Our Patrons

All patrons to go through mandatory temperature checks before entry into the mall or cinema.

(Staff have the right to deny entry of any patron with temperature of 37.5 °C or higher)



SafeEntry

Scan the SafeEntry QR code or your NRIC to check-in during entry and check-out during exit



Social Distancing

Crowd and queue management in place to ensure patrons abide by the safe distancing measures



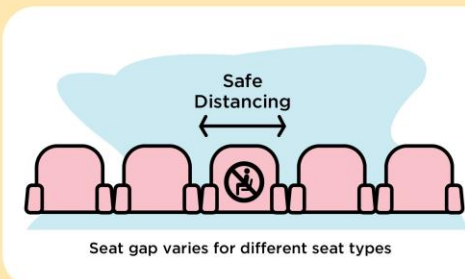
Regular Cleaning & Disinfecting

To clean and disinfect high touch point areas (e.g. counters, toilets, door handles, etc.) and cater additional cleaning time between movies



Staying Safe Together

The use of Automated Ticketing Machines, cashless or contactless payment is encouraged



Seating Arrangement

Seats are reconfigured to ensure safe distancing of at least 1-metre between patrons. A maximum of up to 5 persons (friends and family) will be allowed to sit together and each theatre hall will put in place a capacity limit of maximum 50 patrons. Patrons are required to sit according to prevailing social distancing guidelines
