



Factsheet on Company Led Training Programme (CLT) with MSD

Programme Overview

- 1. The Company Led Training (CLT) Programme is an initiative by Infocomm Media Development Authority (IMDA) to on-board fresh¹ professionals with three years or less of working experience after graduation in ICT or STEM² disciplines, and upskill mid-level professionals with more than three years of working experience for tech job roles through On-the-Job Training (OJT) offered by private-sector companies.
- The CLT Programme with MSD aims to catalyse private-sector companies to invest in the
 upskilling of professionals for tech job roles by collaborating with those that require these
 professionals. Specifically, this programme is structured to provide OJT for job roles that support
 emerging technologies such as Cybersecurity, Data Analytics, Software engineering and Cloud
 Computing etc.
- 3. The CLT Programme consists of OJT, local and / or overseas attachment offered by industry partners, as well as in-depth training through internal and / or external courses. The trainee will acquire practical skills through projects offered and mentored by industry-experienced practitioners. The programme duration may be:
 - Up to 12 months for fresh professionals
 - Up to 6 months for mid-level professionals

Profile of Trainees and Eligibility Criteria

- 4. Trainees eligible for the CLT Programme are to be Singapore Citizens with Diploma / Degree in ICT or STEM disciplines (before the date of enrolment into the programme).
 - a. Fresh Professionals
 - i. In the first 3 years after graduation in ICT or STEM disciplines
 - b. Mid-Level Professionals
 - i. More than 3 years of working experience after graduation in ICT or STEM disciplines

Programme Support

- 5. Trainees selected for the programme will receive funding support for qualified items such as:
 - Monthly stipends during OJT;
 - b. Fees to attend in-depth training courses in emerging technologies; and
 - Cost of Living Allowances and return air fare for trainees selected to participate in overseas attachment.

¹ Refers to diploma / degree holders in the first 3 years after graduation.

² STEM refers to Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics.
