Heroes Among Us Season II (10 episodes)	Fortnightly	May	This is a returning program. The show features Singaporeans who help the community here or in the region or have overcome challenges in their life and come good. Through the profiles, we see the different communities here and in the region that need our help. We see the different adversities that people have to overcome, sometimes taking an almost superhuman effort to do so.
