## TELECOMMUNICATIONS (COMPOSITION OF OFFENCES) REGULATIONS 2005

#### ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

## Regulation

- 1. Citation and commencement
- 2. Compoundable offences
- 3. Revocation

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 64 of the Telecommunications Act, the Info-communications Development Authority of Singapore, with the approval of the Minister for Information, Communications and the Arts, hereby makes the following Regulations:

#### Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Telecommunications (Composition of Offences) Regulations 2005 and shall come into operation on 11th November 2005.

### Compoundable offences

- **2.** The following offences may be compounded by the Authority in accordance with section 64 (1) of the Act:
  - (a) any offence under section 21 (7), 26 (8), 29 (6) or (9), 31 (1), 32, 32E (3), 33
  - (1), (3) or (4), 34 (2), 35 (1) or (3), 39, 40 (1), 45, 46, 48, 49 (1), (2) or (3), 52 or 59 (6) of the Act;
  - (b) any offence under the Telecommunications (Certificates of Competency for Ship Station Operators) Regulations (Rg 1);
  - (c) any offence under the Telecommunications (Cable Detection Workers) Regulations (Rg 4);
  - (d) any offence under the Telecommunications (Radio-communication) Regulations (Rg 5);
  - (e) any offence under the Telecommunications (Dealers) Regulations (Rg 6); and
  - (f) any offence under the Telecommunications (Internal Wiring) Regulations 2005 (G.N. No. S 479/2005).

## Revocation

3. The Telecommunications (Composition of Offences) Regulations (Rg 2) are revoked.
