Infocomm Leadership & Development Programme (iLEAD)



iLEAD - Overview

> Aim

Transform S'pore's infocomm manpower landscape to ensure long-term competitiveness of the sector

> Need for Strategic Capability Devt

- S'pore's infocomm manpower capabilities must keep up with the pace technology advances
- S'pore must have ready pool of infocomm prof. for new growth areas
- Quality manpower is key to attract infocomm investments to S'pore

iLEAD - Overview

> Identified high-end, niche areas

- Key industry players have indicated such areas as key to transforming S'pore's infocomm manpower landscape
- Notable infocomm organisations in the global space have started to invest & develop such capabilities
- IDA has deemed these areas as strategic

iLEAD – Key Features

> Coverage

- Infocomm prof. who secure attachments with coys
- Existing employees / infocomm professionals

> Mechanisms

1. On-the-Job Training via Attachments

- Local / overseas attachments in MNCs, iLEs, R&D centres / research institutes, academic institutions
 - Duration: 3 12 months
 - IDA to provide monthly training grant for trainees, co-fund return airfare & living allowance



iLEAD – Key Features

> Mechanisms (cont'd)

2. Professional Development Courses

- Local / overseas specialised professional courses
 - Duration: up to 3 months
 - IDA to co-fund: course &/or certification fee; return airfare & living allowance for overseas courses
- Trainees to serve a bond with their respective coy or the infocomm industry

iTAP - Overview

> Aim

 To ensure that skills & competencies of S'pore's infocomm talent continue to be relevant & up-to-date in infocomm industry

> Need to attract, develop & retain infocomm talent

- Fresh grads & infocomm prof. to have opportunities to upskill & gain hands-on industry experience
 - Via local attachments in infocomm areas of work with companies in S'pore



iTAP – Key Features

	Fresh Graduates	Infocomm Professionals
Criteria	Citizens/PRs	
Local attachment duration	Min. 6 – Max. 24 months	Min. 6 – Max. 12 months
Training grants	Monthly training grants provided – amt. depends on trainees' qualifications & years of working experience	
Type of attachment	Infocomm-related attachment in applicable infocomm or end- user coy	
Bond requirements	Bond to be served in the company providing attachment (if hired), or in the industry in an infocomm-related job. Bond duration equivalent to attachment period	

- > Number of trainees must be above firms' existing headcount
- > iTAP will be part of Professional Skills Programme Traineeship scheme
 - Umbrella programme for manpower measures during ec. downturn & beyond
 - Multi-agency scheme EDB, IE S'pore, Spring, MAS, MPA, WDA & IDA

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
