

ANNEX B: OVERVIEW OF THE NATIONAL INFOCOMM COMPETITION 2008

The National Infocomm Competition 2008 is an annual year-long infocomm competition that allows students to hone their skills and showcase their talent in infocomm. There are 12 challenges in total.

The competition is divided into three circuits: Secondary School, Junior College and Polytechnic/Institute of Technical Education. Points will be awarded for the top winners in each challenge. For each circuit, the school with the highest accumulated points will be the circuit champion. Should there be a tie, the school with the highest number of top prizes will emerge the winner.
