





Infrastructure — Public Services Infrastructure (PSi)

- PSi Rapid deployment of services on the web
- Issue:
 - Long time-to-market
 - Duplicate effort many services essentially similar (e.g. licensing, application etc)
- Solution:
 - Repeatability, componentisation, scalability, robustness, centralised enablement-decentralised deployment
 - Leverage on 'building blocks'
 Government

New Singapore Shares (www.nss.gov.sg)

- Prime Minister's vision of a New Singapore
- Give Singaporeans a stake in New Singapore

- Conceived, developed & deployed in 16 days
 - New website
 - 2 e-services for users: check share allotment & request for cash exchange
 - 1 e-service for counter staff
- Multi-organisation collaboration:
















New Singapore Shares





eBizCore (www.rcb.gov.sg)

- BIZFILE Internet electronic filing by the general public
- BIZFILE Intranet RCB officers to administer submission made by public users
- BIZFILE Batch public users fill forms offline and then submit the completed forms online through BIZFILE Internet





eBizCore

- 20 June 2001 Start of implementation
- 15 January 2002
 - Application of New Company's Name
 - Registration of Local Company
- 13 January 2003
 - Completion of eBizCore applications




