CODE OF PRACTICE FOR COMPETITION IN THE
PROVISION OF TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICES

DESIGNATION OF DOMINANT LICENSEES

1. It is hereby notified for general information that, pursuant to Section 2.3 of the Code of Practice for Competition in the Provision of Telecommunication Services (the “Code”), the Info-communications Development Authority of Singapore hereby designates the following entities that have been granted licences under Section 5 of the Telecommunications Act as dominant, with effect from 29 September 2000 —

- (1) Singapore Telecommunications Ltd, which expression shall exclude its subsidiaries that hold separate licences issued by the Info-communications Development Authority of Singapore; and
- (2) Singapore CableVision Ltd.

2. Without prejudice to sub-paragraph 1(2), the Info-communications Development Authority of Singapore hereby exempts Singapore CableVision Ltd from the provisions applicable to Dominant Licensees contained in the Code except for Sub-sections 3.3.2 – 3.3.5 and 7.2 – 7.2.2.2, provided that Sub-section 3.3.5 shall not be construed to require Singapore CableVision Ltd to offer the unbundling of cable modem (broadband transport) service for the provision of Internet access service.
