- M1 welcomes the move taken by IDA in developing the Telecom Consolidation Guidelines
 as it provides greater clarity and transparency with regards to the implementation of
 Consolidation Review provisions contained in Section 9 of the Telecom Competition Code.
 As Consolidations, when left unchecked, could potentially lead to anti-competitive
 behaviour, M1 appreciates this platform provided by IDA for industry members to feedback
 on the relevant regulatory issues and help contribute to the development of a competitive
 telecommunication market.
- 2. In general, M1 agrees with the framework of the guidelines. By addressing various issues that are important in considering whether a consolidation should be approved, such as the market situation and the impact of the consolidation on the market, IDA has aimed to set up a reviewing process which is fair and transparent to Licensees.
- 3. However, IDA should clarify some of the terminology and concepts used in the consultation paper, as they tend to be either confusing or rather ambiguous in their definitions. There are also certain areas in the reviewing process that M1 believes IDA could achieve greater transparency.
