DIRECTION OF THE INFO-COMMUNICATIONS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF SINGAPORE: IDA'S PUBLIC CONSULTATION ON PROPOSED INTERCONNECTION OFFER FOR THE PROVISION OF SERVICES ON THE NEXT GENERATION NATIONAL BROADBAND NETWORK – ADDITIONAL SCHEDULES


1. The Info-communications Development Authority of Singapore (“**IDA**”), pursuant to the Info-communications Development Authority of Singapore Act (Chapter 137A), Section 27(1) of the Telecommunications Act (Chapter 323) and Condition 32.1 of OpenNet’s Licence to Provide Facilities-Based Operations issued on 1 April 2009, hereby issues this Direction to OpenNet Pte Ltd (“**OpenNet**”).
2. OpenNet submitted an additional proposed Interconnection Offer (“**ICO**”) schedule, namely, Schedule 12A - QP to QP Interconnection Service, as well as OpenNet’s proposed consequential changes to Schedule 15 - Charges and Schedule 18 - Dictionary to IDA for approval, to enable a NetCo Requesting Licensee to connect its co-located equipment to that of another Requesting Licensee who have successfully obtained co-location service within the same OpenNet’s Central Office.
3. Having carefully reviewed OpenNet’s proposed additional ICO schedules, IDA has concluded that the terms and conditions of OpenNet’s proposed Schedule 12A, Schedule 15 and Schedule 18 require further modification to ensure that they are relevant to the industry’s needs and comply with the requirements of the NetCo Interconnection Code 2009.
4. Accordingly, IDA hereby directs OpenNet as follows:-
 - (a) OpenNet must submit to IDA for review and approval, **by 21 August 2009**, OpenNet’s proposed modifications to OpenNet’s proposed Schedule 12A, Schedule 15, and Schedule 18 to give effect to IDA’s required modifications as specified in Appendices 1, 2 and 3 to this Direction.

IDA also directs OpenNet to make such editorial changes as are necessary to ensure, for instance, that all references used in the ICO and Schedules of the ICO are applicable, correct and relevant.

(Unless the context requires otherwise, all capitalised terms used in the appendices to this Direction shall have the same meanings as in OpenNet's ICO.)

- (b) To the extent that any ancillary or consequential modification to any provision in OpenNet's ICO is necessary in order to give effect to this Direction and/or the modifications required hereunder, IDA requires OpenNet to propose such modification for IDA's approval.
 - (c) In proposing modifications to OpenNet's ICO to give effect to this Direction, IDA reminds OpenNet that:-
 - (i) to the extent that any of OpenNet's proposed modifications fails to effectively implement IDA's required modifications or, in IDA's view, is not acceptable, IDA will direct OpenNet to adopt specific drafting language; and
 - (ii) IDA will reject any proposed modification by OpenNet that is not for the purpose of giving effect to IDA's required modifications as set out in this Direction.
5. The reasons for this Direction are set out in the accompanying Explanatory Memorandum to this Direction as well as the directed modifications stated in Appendices 1, 2 and 3.
6. OpenNet must submit one hardcopy and one softcopy, both in clean and marked-up versions, of its ICO incorporating OpenNet's proposed modifications to effect IDA's required modifications. The marked-up version must clearly identify the proposed modifications made by OpenNet to its ICO. The softcopy submission must be in Adobe PDF and Microsoft Word format and emailed to Lee_Noog@ida.gov.sg, at the same time that OpenNet submits to IDA the hardcopy of the proposed modifications.
7. Any clarification required on this Direction must be made in writing and marked for the attention of our Mr Andrew J. Haire (Deputy Director-General (Telecoms & Post)) and faxed to 6211 2116. Please note that any query directed by OpenNet to IDA for clarification shall not affect OpenNet's obligation to comply fully with this Direction.
