RELEVANT LICENCE CONDITIONS¹ FOR TELECOMMUNICATION DEALER'S (INDIVIDUAL) LICENCE

- 1. The Licensee shall not import and sell any equipment (with embedded overseas SIM card) that may be used in machine-to-machine communications ("M2M Equipment") unless IMDA's prior written approval is obtained. For the avoidance of doubt, the Licensee is required to seek IMDA's prior written approval for each model of M2M Equipment that it intends to import into Singapore.
- 2. Prior to the sale of such M2M Equipment, the Licensee is required to (i) inform the customers/purchasers the identity of the M2M service provider, and the location (e.g., country) where data from the M2M device and related application are being stored; and (ii) obtain the customers'/purchasers' approvals on the installation and use of the M2M Equipment.
- 3. Where the Licensee imports and sells any M2M Equipment, the Licensee shall maintain a register containing full and accurate records for all such M2M Equipment, which shall be made available for inspection by any of the authorised Singapore government agency. The records shall contain the following particulars: (i) the International Mobile Equipment Identity ("IMEI"), the International Mobile Subscriber Identity ("IMSI") and the Mobile Subscriber Integrated Services Digital Network Number ("MSISDN") (where applicable) of the SIM card; and (ii) information relating to the identification of the M2M Equipment (i.e. Brand name, Model Number, and Serial Number).
- 4. IMDA reserves the right to require the Licensee to record any other details as necessary in its register of M2M Equipment.
- 5. The records in the register shall be kept at the Licensee's premises in Singapore for a period of not less than 12 calendar months from the date of expiry of the projected useful life of the M2M Equipment as declared by the Licensee to IMDA, where the projected useful life commences from the date of sale/leased of the M2M Equipment.
- 6. The Licensee shall ensure that all the M2M Equipment imported or sold by the Licensee are configured to be used only for the purposes approved by IMDA and not for other purposes (such as voice communications or text messaging) unless IMDA's prior written approval has been obtained.

- 7. Notwithstanding condition 3 of the Licence, the Licensee shall be permitted to sell M2M Equipment (which is built into and forms an integral part of the device) for local use, provided that IMDA's prior written approval has been obtained for the importation of such M2M Equipment. For the avoidance of doubt, nothing herein permits the Licensee to sell M2M Equipment on a standalone basis for local use.
- 8. Conditions 11 and 12² of the Licence shall be waived with respect to M2M Equipment (which is built into and forms an integral part of the device) imported by the Licensee, provided that IMDA's prior written approval has been obtained for the importation of such M2M Equipment. For the avoidance of doubt, this waiver does not apply to M2M Equipment on a stand-alone basis.

CONDITIONS 11 AND 12 OF THE DEALER'S (INDIVIDUAL) LICENCE CONDITIONS

- 11. The Licensee shall display telecommunication equipment which is not registered equipment separately from registered equipment at each of his business premises. In this regard, the Licensee shall:
 - (a) put up a sign for the telecommunication equipment which is not registered equipment; or
 - (b) affix a label on telecommunication equipment which is not registered equipment.

12. The Licensee shall -

- (a) affix or ensure that there is affixed, on all registered equipment intended for use in Singapore or on the equipment's instruction manual or packaging, such labels as the Authority may specify stating or indicating that the equipment complies with the standards and specifications published by the Authority before such equipment is displayed or offered for sale;
- (b) affix or ensure that there is affixed such other labels as the Authority considers necessary on any telecommunication equipment before such telecommunication equipment is displayed or offered for sale;
- (c) ensure that every advertisement, pamphlet, or brochure relating to any telecommunication equipment which he sells or offers for sale contains such information as the Authority may specify;
- (d) refrain from affixing on (i) any telecommunication equipment which is not a registered equipment; (ii) any advertisement, pamphlet or brochure relating to any such telecommunication equipment; and (iii) any instruction manual or packaging of any such telecommunication equipment, any label stating or indicating that the telecommunication equipment complies with the standards and specifications published by the Authority; and
- (e) comply with such other labelling requirements as may be published by the Authority.
