

## **ANNEX 1: TeSA for ITE and Polytechnics Alliance (TIP Alliance) Factsheet**

1. In the spirit of Forward Singapore, the Infocomm Media Development Authority (IMDA), together with Industry players, has set up the new TechSkills Accelerator (TeSA) for ITE and Polytechnics Alliance (“**TIP Alliance**”) on 1 Sept 2022. This Alliance has been formed, following an announcement in March this year, at the Ministry of Communications and Information’s Committee of Supply (COS) Debates. The TIP Alliance will equip Singaporean students and graduates from Polytechnics and Institute of Technical Education (ITE) with the skills to take up tech job opportunities, and share in Singapore’s digital growth. It is projected to contribute 1,000 tech job opportunities over three years.

2. The TIP Alliance is industry-led and spearheaded by Mr Wong Wai Meng, Chairman of SGTech and Mr Sam Liew, President of Singapore Computer Society (refer to **Annex 1.1** for the Co-Chairpersons’ profiles) and supported by the Ministry of Communications and Information, the Ministry of Education, all five Polytechnics and the Institute of Technical Education. Senior Minister of State, Ministry of Communications and Information, Mr Tan Kiat How, serves as Advisor to the TIP Alliance.

3. The TIP Alliance comprises global and local companies that employ tech talent, including Accenture, Carousell, DBS, Dell Technologies, Ensign InfoSecurity, Google, GovTech, IBM, Inspire-Tech, NCS, PSA International, Singtel, and ST Engineering (refer to **Annex 1.2** for company profiles).

4. Over the next three years, the TIP Alliance aims to place and train Polytechnic and ITE graduates with tech qualifications, drive the shift in hiring practices in industry from qualification-based to skills-based, giving capable jobseekers equal opportunities to succeed, and shape the Polytechnic and ITE curriculum to stay relevant with industry trends. Participating companies will endeavour to provide clear end-to-end pathways for students and graduates to kickstart their careers in tech jobs across various sectors and acquire relevant skills. These include providing high quality internships, on-the-job training via apprenticeships, as well as opportunities to obtain further education and industry-recognised certifications. This is so graduates can achieve better career growth and maximise their potential, regardless of their starting point or educational background.

5. More companies are expected to join the TIP Alliance to provide more job opportunities for Singaporean Polytechnic and ITE students and graduates.
