NOTICE –

**AMENDMENTS TO THE CODE OF PRACTICE FOR COMPETITION IN THE
PROVISION OF TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICES (“CODE 2012”)**

**DESIGNATION OF MONOPOLES AND TOWERS (EXCLUDING TOWERS
USED FOR THE OPERATION OF BROADCASTING SERVICE) AS
INFRASTRUCTURE TO BE SHARED UNDER SECTION 7.5.1 OF THE CODE
2012**

1. In exercise of its powers under section 26(1) of the Telecommunications Act, the Info-communications Development Authority of Singapore hereby amends the Code 2012 with effect from 29 June 2012 in the manner as specified in paragraph 2 below.

2. Sections 7.5.1(b) and (c) of the Code 2012 are deleted and substituted as follows:

“(b) in-building cabling (where the occupant elects to take Service from another service provider);

(c) lead-in ducts and associated manholes;

(d) monopoles; and

(e) radio towers (excluding towers used for the operation of any broadcasting service).”.

3. For the avoidance of doubt, save for the above amendments, no other changes have been made to the Code 2012, which continues to be in force.
