# POSTAL SERVICES ACT (CHAPTER 237A)

## POSTAL SERVICES (CLASS LICENCE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2008

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 61 of the Postal Services Act, the Info-communications Development Authority of Singapore, with the approval of the Minister for Information, Communications and the Arts, hereby makes the following Regulations:

#### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Postal Services (Class Licence) (Amendment) Regulations 2008 and shall come into operation on 2nd May 2008.

#### **Application**

**2.** The conditions specified in the Schedule to the Postal Services (Class Licence) Regulations 2005 as amended by regulation 3 shall apply to every class licence granted under those Regulations, whether granted before, on or after 2nd May 2008.

#### **Amendment of Schedule**

- **3.** The Schedule to the Postal Services (Class Licence) Regulations 2005 (G.N. No. S 481/2005) is amended
  - (a) by deleting paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 and substituting the following paragraph:
    - **"2.** The licensee must, upon delivery of each express letter, obtain a written acknowledgment of delivery from the person receiving the express letter."; and
  - (b) by deleting paragraph 6.
