Subject Mobile TV

If you are referring to the tv programs onboard some SBS buses, here are my comments.

Except for the news bulletins and short scripts like "GAGS" or "Just For Laughs" the sound generated is a nuisance and irritation to commuters like me who want some peace while in the bus.
