Broadcaster may use the rating code as proposed (e.g. 0x0D for M18). However, the proposed definition deviates from DVB definition (16 years old and above).

Australian specification is closer to DVB definition.

There is no issue from Broadcast perspective. However, non compliant receivers may implement based on DVB definitions (e.g. keying in the age instead of rating classification) and the outcome of parental lock feature differs from expectation.
