Re: Second Consultation on 5G Mobile services and Networks

Dear Ms Aileen Chia

As a mother of two young children I write with great concern for the proposed roll-out of 5G mobile service in Singapore without the necessary and required research having been undertaken to demonstrate what the impact of this technology is on human health.

The implications of 5G will vastly increase the overall levels of microwave radiation in Singapore, with mini-cells being placed everywhere and no regard for schools, residences or office spaces. The levels in Singapore are already high in comparison with other countries.

More and more countries are delaying/postponing or suspending the roll-out of 5G based on the latest research that shows that this technology is connected to the onset of cancer, plus many other health issues. Belgium has put a stop to 5G, Italy are halting the rollout of 5G, the Netherlands will not commission 5G until radiation research is undertaken. Russia have refused to allow network operators to proceed and many states in the US are implementing various strategies to reduce and control the increase in radiation that will be caused by 5G.

I urge the Singapore government to launch an independent enquiry to fully investigate this matter before proceeding any further.
