Notes to New Entrant Bid Document

Defined terms used in the New Entrant Bid Document and these Notes to the New Entrant Bid Document shall have the meanings given to such terms in the Auction Rules, unless expressly specified otherwise.

NOTE 1.2: Indicate the value of the bid made by the New Entrant Bidder.

Note that the bid will only be considered a Valid New Entrant Bid according to the Auction Rules if it is equal to or in increments of whole Singapore dollars above the total Reserve Price for the four (4) 2.5 GHz Spectrum Lots (i.e. a minimum bid of S\$ 40,000,000). IDA reserves the right to clarify or reject any New Entrant Bids that it does not consider to be Valid.
