

REVISED TELECOMMUNICATION WIRING WORK LICENSING FRAMEWORK FOR WIRING INSTALLERS AND CONTRACTORS

- From 1 April 2024, only the installation of **optical fibre cables** will be regulated. Copper cable installation will no longer be regulated.
- Installers and contractors installing **optical fibre cables** will need a new Telecommunication Wiring Installer or Contractor Class Licence.

1 Starting February 2024

Installers and contractors can start applying for the new Telecommunication Wiring Installer or Contractor Class Licence via GoBusiness Licensing portal:

To apply for the new wiring licence, installers are required to attend an IMDA recognised optical fibre cable course and get a:

- Certificate of Competency in Fibre Optic Cabling from ITE **or**
- Certificate from other IMDA-approved courses.

Other IMDA approved courses and course providers will be added soon.

Experienced installers may apply for exemption to attend the training course if they:

- are working for telecommunication service providers (Telcos) or Telcos' contractors for the installation of optical fibre cable; and
- have one-year relevant experience in installing optical fibre cable with no complaints.

2 Starting 1 April 2024

- Existing installer and contractor licences will cease to be valid
- Installers and contractors will need to have the new Class licences to install optical fibre cables.
