**Comments:** 

We understand that replacing the traditional Signalling System No. 7 (SS7) protocol with an IP-based signalling protocol introduces inherent security vulnerabilities. Furthermore, the increasing volume of IP-based traffic necessitates a move towards a more scalable and secure IP-based interconnection at points of interconnection (POIs).

As an SBO license holder, we currently maintain both IP-based interconnection and PSTN (ISDN) services with Singtel. We plan to migrate our remaining PSTN circuits to IP-based interconnection within the next 1-2 years.

In relation to the proposed Reference Interconnection Offer (RIO), we seek clarification on the following points:

- 1. Will there be any cost variation for IP-based interconnection services after 28 February 2027?
- 2. Will the new RIO necessitate any changes to our existing IP-based interconnection (SIP trunk)?
- 3. Will there be any impact on the current Number Retention Service (Number Porting) process?
